

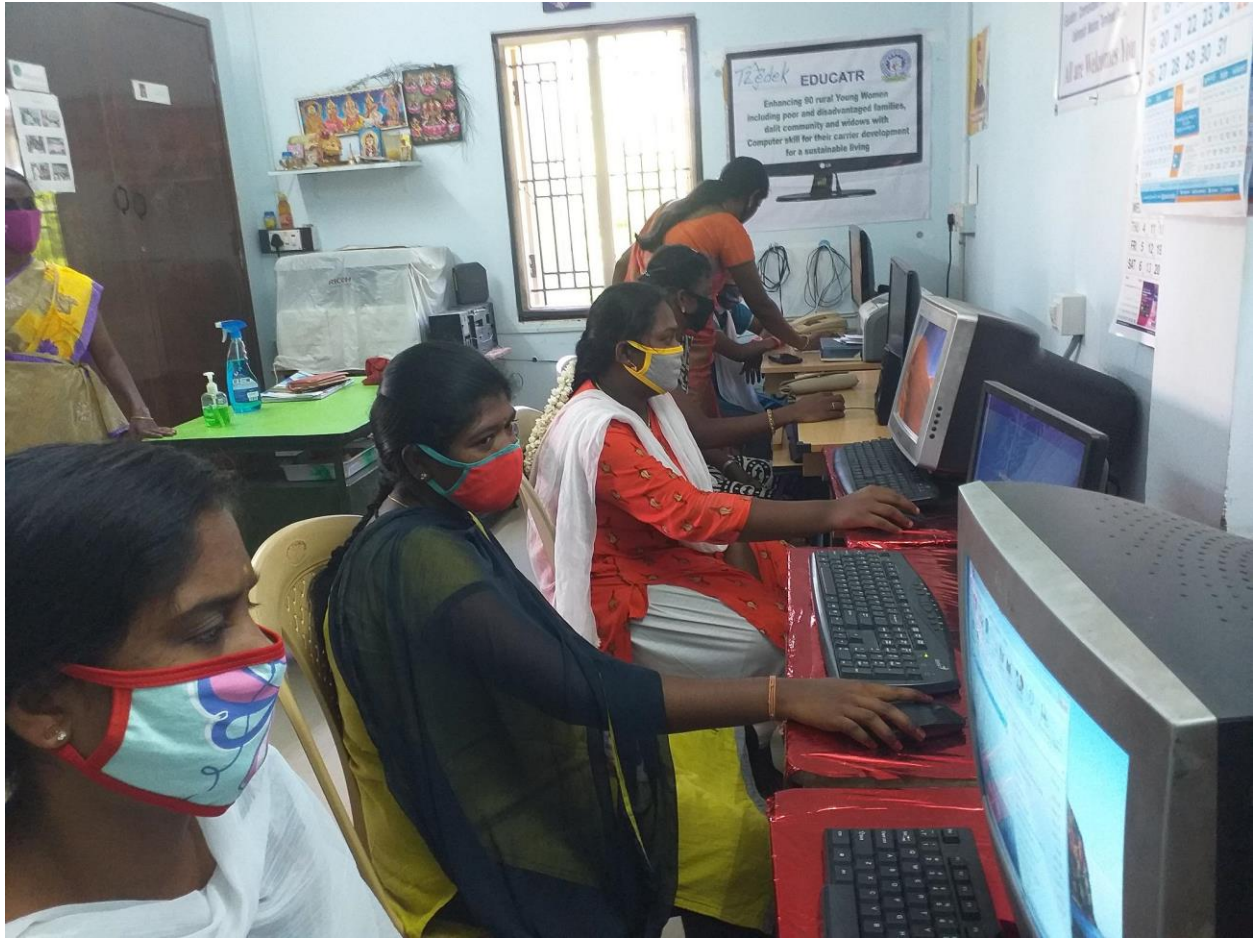
Computer Skill Education Programme for girls and young women:

Situation of poverty in families and unskilled nature left many vulnerable women and young girls could not able to get sustained income to support their families. EDUCATR in partnership with TZEDEK – UK started computer skill training programme for 90 girls and young women on 14 Sep 2019. The project has been conducted for a period of 12 months by providing computer skills. Each training course has been conducted for a period of 04 months and three training courses are conducted in 12 months. 30 young women are given training for a course and totally 90 young women are planned to provide computer skill training. As planned, the training programme for the first batch has been successfully completed. We started the second batch on 18 Jan 2020 but we have conducted course till 20 March 2020 and continue further as planned due the curfew and lock-down imposed by both State and Central Government due to COVID 19. However the training programme has been resumed after three months break. With the support of TZEDEK UK and understanding the situation, the computer skill training centre instructor had been paid salary for three months.



The details of Project Activities during the reporting period:

All the ongoing project activities has been suspended during the COVID 19 PANDEMIC from April 2020.



The computer skill training programme resumed since 05 July 2021. We followed the safe and protection of beneficiaries coming for the training by washing their hands and legs with water before entering the centre, apply sanitizer and wear masks during the training. Totally 90 girls and young women completed the training and they all at present got employment and self income activities.
