

GURU KRUPA FOUNDATION - Education Support for Children: 2021-2022

Last year, with support from GKF, EDUCATR started a bridge school education system. This was meant to address the issue of learning loss that the children experienced due to closure of schools during COVID.

The bridge sessions run after school hours in 10 surrounding villages. Each location supports 25-35 students. They run for 2 hours, and are meant to supplement the education the children receive in school.

They also serve as a means to bring children who have dropped out from school for various family reasons back into the education system. Last year, GKF provided the funds to get started with this program.

This year GKF is continuing the support for this program. In addition, GKF is also providing funds for paying for the fees of 130 children at the Chkkravarthi Vidyalaya school.

In addition, GKF also provided funds to run computer literacy lessons on the weekends at the bridge schools.

Finally, to address health and nutrition shortcomings, GKF is providing funds to provide nutrition supplements to 300 children 3 times a week at the bridge schools.
