

Since 1997, we have been dedicated to improving the lives of disadvantaged women and children in Tamil Nadu, India. Our core program includes running a nursery and primary school, while advocating for the enrollment of children who come from vulnerable backgrounds, and creating a hospitable environment to teach children with a myriad of disabilities. Another core program includes empowering marginalized women through the creation of 500+ female-led, self-help groups in over 250 villages in the towns of Usilampatti, Chellampatti, Sedapatti and Elumalai in Tamil Nadu, India. With the assistance of the self-help groups, we have also provided seed funding & support to promote organic farming, while concurrently supporting street vendors in the region.
